- Applicants should prepare the following documents in order:
 - 1. One completed <u>Application Form</u> for Exchange Student.
 - 2. One 2"x2" head & shoulder photos in color (taken within the last six months).
 - 3. One photocopies of the certificate of enrollment from applicant's home institution.
 - 4. One official copies of transcripts.
 - 5. One recommendation letter from applicant's instructor at home institution.
 - 6. A copy of passport.
 - 7. Study plan (One A4 page: Purposes of Exchanging & Course Scheme).
 - 8. On/Off-Campus Accommodation Application for Overseas Students.
 - 9. A photocopy of Health Insurance which covers the duration of student's stay in Taiwan. (After a continuous residence within Taiwan for six months, students must enroll in the National Health Insurance program.)
 - 10. A copy of Health Certificate Form B.
 - 11. Authorization for Emergency Medication.
 - 12. Affidavit of waive student group insurance.
 - 13. Exchange student behavior protocol



Application Documents and Procedures

*Students should purchase his/her overseas insurance and present the copy of the insurance certificate to the Office of International Cross-strait Cooperation. If not, the student will have to purchase the Group Insurance offered at NTD 2,500.
